PLAN FOR 2025:

- **Trees and Shrubs – all planted**

1. Oak x 3
2. Whip plants (native hedgerow) x 200
3. Fruit – 2 x apple, 2 x cherry, 2 x pear
4. Clearing trees to open up the canopy to allow light in to increase diversity (? collaboration with horticultural society)

- **Install nest boxes and locations**

1. 1 x tawny owl (in hawthorn area)
2. 2 x kestrel – Spring Close
3. 1 x barn owl - ? location – Robin or ? other barns in village
4. 12 x tit boxes – Top Hedges, church, Spring Close, hawthorn thicket, memorial garden
5. 6 x robin boxes - Top Hedges, church, Spring Close, hawthorn thicket, memorial garden
