## REPLACEMENT OF DEFIBRILLATOR BATTERIES AND PADS/NEW MACHINES

- The 2 defib machines the PC owns are discontinued and new batteries and pads are hard to get hold of as stock is limited and may well run out totally soon.
- The current pads/batteries expire in February 2026.
- The cost of spare pads and battery pack (sold together) are £174 each so £348 for 2. (this contains 2 pads/1 battery as the 1 pad/1 battery is out of stock)
- It is advised that these are ordered now to ensure they are received by February. Last time, the pads were out of date by the time the new ones arrived.

## Decision needed;

- 1. Buy replacement batteries/pads now at a cost of £348 and think about new machines later next year.
- 2. Resolve to replace the old type machines and order some in April, saving £348, spending £2385 minimum.
- 3. Resolve to buy 3 of the offer ones now at £1647 see below and save £1638 on the full price of £1095 per machine.
- If the PC resolves to replace the defib machines next year (ie build it into the budget and purchase in April) the risk with out-of-date pads is minimal and would not be an issue for 2-3 months. The battery life needs checking though being done. If this is ok, new machines can possibly be purchased asap in April 2026 and a saving of £348 is made.
- Alternatively, new pads/battery are purchased now to ensure they arrive by February, and this gives more time to purchase new defib machines. Pads tend to last 2y.
- There is a thought that a new defib machine should be sited at the playing field now it is hired out more regularly for sport. This is the most likely place an incident would occur.
- Probably need to factor in a community training session this has been requested previously and it was thought to wait until a new machine was installed.
